



# **SPEAKERS**



#### **OLE FRANK NIELSEN**

Ole Frank Nielsen is an expert in Higher Education communication - especially through social media. He has developed (are currently managing) the SoMechannels of Aarhus University - second largest University in Denmark. He has worked with SoMe channels since 2010 and is an energtic networker with other universities, and has founded the Social Media Managers at Uni Facebook-group with nearly 500 members from Finland in the Northeast to Portugal in the Southwest. Ole's mantra is to work smarter - in the sense that it is important to use the profiles of students and scientists as brand ambassadors.



## **TERESA RUÃO**

Professor at the Department of Communication Sciences at the University of Minho, since 1995. Researcher at the Center for Studies in Communication and Society, since its foundation in 2001. PhD in Communication Sciences, in 2008. She is currently Pro-Rector for Institutional Communication at Minho's University. She was Vice-President and President of the Pedagogical Council of the Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Minho, between 2009 and 2019. She was Deputy Director of the Center for Studies in Communication and Society, between 2019 and 2021. She is an evaluator of the Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, since 2017, and the National Accreditation Agency, since 2019. She teaches and researches in the areas of Organizational and Strategic Communication, Brands and Public Relations.



#### **SARA BALONAS**

Assistant professor at the Institute of Social Sciences of the University of Minho and researcher at the Research Center in Communication and Society (CECS). PhD in Communication Sciences - Advertising in the Social Sphere. She teaches Strategic Communication, Branding, Advertising and Creativity. The research work is focused on the reconfiguration of advertising, its role in society beyond consumption and as a contribution to a better practice of citizenship.

Deputy Director of the Degree in Communication Sciences (University of Minho). Founder and CEO of B+ Comunicação, an advertising company created in 2002. Founder of Be True - Program for sustainability and social responsibility (2010). She works voluntarily as a member of the board of Associação Bagos d'Outro (since 2010) and All4 Integrity (created in 2021). She was a member of the board of ADDICT-agency for the creative industries. She was an entrepreneurship ambassador appointed by the European Commission (2010-2013).



#### **ELSA LEMOS**

Crisis Communication Specialist with 18 years of experience. Her purpose is to create and train for a culture of crisis communication in Portugal. She prepares people and organizations, from public, private and non-profit entities to communicate in crisis situations. Among its clients are sectors such as finance and critical infrastructure. She has a master's degree in Information Warfare, from the Military Academy, and a degree in Communication Sciences, from Universidade Lusófona. She is a Crisis Management Auditor by the National Defense Institute and has the International Certification in DISC Analysis by Power Coaching.

At University level, Elsa is a professor in the chair of Media and Public Opinion at the Military Academy (PT) and is an assiduous presence in the Introduction to Social Communication Course (CICS), at the Military University Institute (IUM), in the Joint General Staff Course (CEMC) and the Promotion to General Officer Course (CPOG). She also participated in the Course in Peace Operations and Humanitarian Aid (OPAH), of the IGC / Human Rights Center of the Faculty of Law of Coimbra.

#### **JOANA LOBO ANTUNES**



# SOCIAL PROGRAMME

#### **RECTORY BUILDING OF THE UNIVERSITY OF PORTO**

Standing on the old Monte do Olival grove in Gomes Teixeira Square, the building that now houses the Rectorate of the University of Porto was built on the foundations of the College of Orphaned Boys and the Church of Our Lady of Grace (XVII century). Currently, and in addition to the Rectorate services, here are domiciled the Old Library Fund, the Natural History and Science Museum. More recently, the building houses the U.Porto Shop and the Art Gallery (Galeria dos Leões).



### **BIODIVERSITY GALLERY AND BOTANICAL GARDEN**

Located in one of the most emblematic places in Porto - the Botanical Garden, which with it integrates the second pole of the MHNC-UP (Natural History and Science Museum of the University of Porto), the Biodiversity Gallery is the first Ciência Viva Centre specifically dedicated to biodiversity. A space where art intersects with biology and natural history, stimulating a panoply of sensory experiences, purposefully and carefully designed to celebrate the diversity of life, the Biodiversity Gallery is the world's first museum space created from scratch according to the philosophy of total museology.



### **LIVRARIA LELLO**

Livraria Lello has been a bookstore very much of its times ever since 1906, carrying within it over a century of history and stories, imbued into its architectural surroundings and also into the bookish knowledge that shape the experiences of those who visit and those who read. One of the oldest Portuguese bookstores, Livraria Lello is an emblematic place in the city of Porto, a must-see for anyone passing through. Although it is a hundred years old, it continues to live in perfect harmony with its time, being more alive, more lively and more dynamic than ever. Keeping books at the centre of all its activities, it uses them to host and promote a rich cultural programme, which includes various events, artistic installations, and temporary and permanent exhibitions.



#### **WOW-WORLD OF WINE**

In centuries old Port wine cellars in Vila Nova de Gaia, Porto, WOW pays homage to the region and shines a light on the most important Portuguese industries and traditions. But WOW is more than museums, it is an entire district full of new and exciting things to do, explore, and learn. Seven museum experiences, twelve restaurants, shops, a temporary exhibition space, an events space and a wine school.



### **UPTEC**

UPTEC - Science and Technology Park of the University of Porto is a pioneering structure in the context of higher education in Portugal, which musters a wide range of startups and private R&D centres around the University of Porto. UPTEC supports the creation and development of business projects in the arts, sciences and technologies, through sharing knowledge between the university and the market. Since its inception, in 2007, UPTEC has supported the development of more than 600 business projects notable for their high degree of innovation, technological intensity, expertise and potential for internationalisation.



### **13S**

Health Research in a single and solid institution could be a definition for i3S, but the Institute for Research and Innovation in Health is so much more. The will of three research institutes - IBMC, INEB and IPATIMUP - to build a better future gave rise to a new building housing a new institution driven to face and overcome the most relevant health challenges society faces today such as: aging, infectious diseases, cancer, regenerative medicine and neurodegenerative diseases.



### **CIIMAR**

CIIMAR - Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research is a leading research and advanced training institution of the University of Porto, working at the frontier of Ocean Knowledge and Innovation. CIIMAR fosters an integrated approach to Ocean and coastal areas promoting the understanding and knowledge of Biological, Physical and Chemical dynamics of these environments and the impact of natural and human activities, aiming to unravel the links between these processes, grasp Ocean and ecosystems functioning and responses to Global Changes.



## **TORREÃO RESTAURANT**


Situated inside a 14<sup>th</sup> century cubicle of the Fernandina Wall, this small restaurant has two rooms that hold 32 people, located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the tower.

Above these, there is an imposing terrace with a 270° view that reaches the Ponte do Infante, the Arrábida Bridge and Passeio das Virtudes, where it is possible to have your meals when weather conditions allow.





#### **HOW TO GET TO FEUP**

#### BY METRO

FEUP is served by three Metro stations on line D (yellow) in zone C6.

Line D (yellow) connects the University Campus station Polo Universitário to Gaia City Hall in about 15 minutes, via Trindade, where it connects to line A (blue), line B (red) and line C (green). Leaving the Polo Universitário station, you should turn left into Rua Dr. Manuel Pereira da Silva and then, after passing Paranhos cemetery, turn left into Rua Dr. Roberto Frias.

Go straight on and you will find FEUP on your right.

Leaving the IPO station, you should go on down to the end of Rua Dr. Plácido da Costa and cross Rua Dr. Roberto Frias. You will then be in front of FEUP.

Leaving the Hospital de São João station, follow the Circunvalação ring road until you come to the junction with Rua Dr. Roberto Frias. Go down that road until the junction with Rua Dr. Plácido da Costa. FEUP will now be on your left.

#### **BY BUS**


There are 4 bus lines in the Faculty's zone: 204, 300, 301 and 803.




#### BY PLANE (Sá Carneiro Airport)

The quickest way of getting to FEUP from the airport (if you do not have transport waiting for you or do not intend to catch a taxi) is to take Metro Line E (purple) into Porto. You will need to change at Trindade station and take Line D (yellow). Then follow the directions given in the option "By Metro".
